4 - The Practice

First of all a framework is prepared by the NSS Program Officer to help the elderly in the above context and then after the approval of the Principal the scheme is implemented. Selfless service is the supreme religion on the basis of which action has been.



Which is as follows?

Students of the NSS unit reach the old age home and contribute lunch, breakfast, snacks etc. to the elderly. Most of all, they spend their time listening to their stories and experiences, not just diagnosing and helping them with their health issues. By developing this dynamism among the students, the college's dream of all-round development among the students comes true.

NCC and NSS volunteers in the community of 15-20 regularly visit old age homes and spend time with the elders by interacting with them, playing games, narrating stories, entertainment videos and short films, puzzles etc. and also entertain them with toys.

The students also learned the importance of being good human and maintaining good human relations.

They are giving their helping hand towards old and deprived old people in the society.

On the other hand, the Principal, NSS Program Officers and staff members provide continuous support to the elders.

The college administration also invites elders in special day celebrations in the college

Also funds are collected by NSS volunteers, other students, NSS program officers and staff members to help the elderly. Festivals are celebrated in old age homes, fruits, warm clothes and necessary materials are distributed to the elderly, and sweets are also distributed on the occasion of Diwali.

The most important thing is that on the evening of Diwali on 24 10 2022, NSS Program Officer and NSS Volunteer celebrated the festival of Diwali by visiting the old age home, burst crackers with the elders, enjoyed the festival like friends with the elders, the elders were happy with this, the elders congratulated the volunteers and NSS Officer. At the same time, the college principal also appreciated his efforts.

The plan in the visit was to make the students aware of the problems faced by the elderly, learn to respect them, care for them and listen to their experiences and their advice. Our volunteers explained to them the plan to run a plastic free campaign

In the above scenario the college staff and students selflessly distribute clothes and essential materials to the surrounding rural areas.

3-The Context

The NSS Program Officer of the college explains the program details to the Coordinators members of this exercise.

And this is also the main objective of the best practices of our college, the college staff and students make continuous efforts to fulfill the meaning of this statement. This makes students familiar with Indian culture and also respects our rural areas people

The first step to fulfill the above objective is to identify those places and needs that require more support and service.

College students are motivated by teachers before these exercises because it is charity

Our college has been striving since the beginning to fulfill the objective

Since 2017, the college staff has been selflessly providing clothes (clothes, woolen clothes, blankets, rain coats, etc.) and essential items (biscuits, bread, pulses, rice, sugar, tea) to the people in the surrounding rural areas. And shoes, pens, pencils, erasers, notebooks, etc. are also distributed especially to children.

Inspired by this sentiment, the college staff donated an amount of Rs 45000 (30/04/2021) to the Government City Hospital of Pipariya to purchase a **CT Scan Machine**



4 -The Practice

Before starting these practices, approval is obtained from the college principal.

The NSS Program Officer of the college explains the program details to the Coordinators members of this exercise.

We serve to grow; we grow to serve. The outreach program of the college aims at providing services, awareness, and facilities in the neighborhood villages.

The college as whole takes part in this activity with interest and enthusiasm. The national service scheme unit of college pipariya plays a major role in bringing up this program and motivating the students.

For this money and other materials are collected by the college staff at their discretion. Three to four teams have been formed under the direction of the Principal. Each team consists of 5 to 6 members. Each team goes to their respective rural areas. Materials are distributed, and the villagers are also educated about major issues (environmental protection, de-addiction, voter awareness, human rights) etc.

In the last five years the college staff has visited about 23 (Tekapar, Dokrikheda, Rampur, Richheda, Panari, Mehdikheda, Samnapur, Siganama, Matkuli, Jhirpa, Jhiriya, Hathwas, Dapka, Piparpani, Mohad, Isarpur, Mahuakheda, Parkhi, Mahalwada, Kursidana, Bariaam, Molkalwada and Sadiya etc) villages which are as follows, we mostly meet the college students in their home villages, there we distribute all the material as per the prescribed team, also make them aware. Issues related to education, human rights, environmental protection, child protection and health.

On the other hand, the Principal, NSS Program Officers and staff members provide continuous support to the rural areas people

The faculty members of the college regularly visited the neighboring rural areas and distributed the needy items to the people with their own efforts. The faculty member devoted the most to this particular exercise as compared to the college students.

Under the best practices, primary schools were visited in several villages by staff members and students of the college, where pens, pencils, shoes and other items were also distributed to the school children

College staff along with this service work helps serve food for homeless or supply a good vessel

Supply stationery/footwear/cloths for children who are homeless

Is installed a be friending system to spend time with disabled students from neighboring rural areas

Efforts have also been made to arrange for the supply of books, or other necessary materials, for special needs education.

Organize a free, public nutrition awareness campaign. Collect comb, toothbrush, soap etc.

Parents do not allow girl students to go to remote areas because the time period is too long
