2. STUDENT'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

The survey results provide a detailed evaluation of various aspects of the college, including curriculum quality, teaching processes, availability of educational resources, examination transparency, and overall student satisfaction. The curriculum quality was rated highly, with 30.6% considering it excellent and 40.3% very good, indicating strong satisfaction. However, 15.6% rated it fair or bad, suggesting room for improvement. The teaching quality received positive feedback, with 26.1% rating it excellent and 35.8% very good, but 18% found it fair or bad, highlighting the need for enhanced teaching methodologies.

The availability of textbooks and reference materials was a concern, with only 22.8% rating it excellent and 27.8% very good, while 24.2% found it fair or bad, indicating a significant need for improvement. The sequencing of course content received mixed reviews: 22.2% rated it excellent and 34.4% very good, but 20.3% rated it fair or bad, suggesting better structuring is needed. The internal examination process was more favorably viewed, with 32.2% rating it excellent and 34.2% very good, although 16.1% still found it fair or bad.

The relevance of the curriculum in the current context was positively rated by 26.1% as excellent and 37.2% very good, yet 18.6% viewed it as fair or bad, indicating the need for continuous updates to align with current trends. The college's role in students' overall development was well-regarded, with 30.3% rating it excellent and 38.6% very good, but 16.4% rated it fair or bad. A significant majority (91.4%) expressed pride in being associated with the college, and 91.7% appreciated recent developmental works.







5. TEACHER'S FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

The survey evaluated various aspects of the curriculum, collecting responses categorized into five ratings: excellent, very good, good, fair, and bad. Regarding the quality of the curriculum, 28% rated it as excellent, 64% as very good, 4% as good, and another 4% as fair, with no respondents rating it as bad. This indicates a high satisfaction level with the curriculum quality. In terms of the desirability and appropriateness of the curriculum sequence, 24% rated it as excellent, 60% as very good, 12% as good, and 4% as fair, again with no bad ratings, showing strong approval of the curriculum structure.

When evaluating the adequacy of available textbooks and reference books, responses were more varied. 12% rated it as excellent, 52% as very good, 28% as good, with no fair ratings, but 8% rated it as bad, indicating some dissatisfaction with the resources provided. Concerning students' ability to understand the curriculum objectives, 12% rated it as excellent, 52% as very good, 24% as good, 4% as fair, and 8% as bad. This suggests that while the majority found it adequate, there is room for improvement.

The relevance of the curriculum in the current scenario was rated predominantly as very good by 60% of respondents, 24% rated it as excellent, 8% each for good and fair, with no bad ratings. This indicates that the curriculum is largely seen as relevant and useful. Finally, the freedom in adopting new assessment techniques and strategies was rated as excellent by 28%, very good by 48%, good by 16%, fair by 4% and bad by another 4% showing general satisfaction but with some room for improvement.

8. ALUMNI FEEDBACK ANALYSIS

The survey conducted to evaluate various aspects of the college experience reveals significant insights. A large portion of respondents, 66.7%, rated the curriculum quality as excellent or very good, while 7.1% found it lacking, suggesting room for improvement. Regarding the teaching process quality, 52.4% found it excellent or very good, but 4.8% rated it poorly, indicating a need for enhancements in teaching methods.

In evaluating the internal exam process's transparency and effectiveness, 57.1% rated it positively, while 9.5% found it deficient, highlighting the need for better transparency. A majority, 66.7%, deemed the curriculum relevant to the current scenario, though 4.8% disagreed, suggesting regular updates to keep pace with industry trends.

An impressive 85.7% of respondents found the knowledge and skills acquired useful for employment, underlining the curriculum's practical value. Additionally, 69.1% acknowledged the college's

role in their overall development, though 2.4% felt it was inadequate, indicating potential areas for enhancement in holistic growth.

A remarkable 92.9% of respondents expressed pride in being alumni, reflecting the positive impact of the college. Furthermore, 88.1% appreciated recent developmental works, recognizing efforts to improve infrastructure and facilities.

The survey identified extra-curricular activities (45.2%), academics (26.2%), and infrastructure (21.4%) as key areas for improvement. A smaller group (7.1%) suggested enhancements in information technology. Overall, while the college experience is generally well-regarded, focusing on these areas will further enhance student satisfaction. Regular feedback and continuous improvement will ensure the college meets the evolving needs of its students, maintaining high standards of education and development.
